Basic regulations:

A Maximum of two players from the same association in each event (boys and girls) will be allowed to participate in the ITTF World Junior Circuit Finals.

Based on a decision by the ITTF World Junior group , only athletes participating **in at least one ITTF World Junior Circuit event in 2002** should be considered for selection by ranking.

Playing format:

Stage 1 RR of 4 players. **Best of five games.** Player will be seeded according to their ranking positions on the ITTF Ranking list (latest version) Athletes from the same association will be drawn into separate groups.

Stage 2 Semifinal and finals - crossover. **Best of seven games.**

Stage 3 Finals

The draw will take place at the official hotel starting at 1700 Wednesday 11 December. All athletes and coaches are requested to participate in the draw/presentation procedures.

Hospitality and Airfare

Free hospitality for athletes traveling more than six time zones will be offered starting from Tuesday 10 December evening.

For all other athletes the ITTF will offer free hospitality starting from Wednesday 11 December.

Airfare support will be paid according to the following scheme: Athletes from **Japan, China and Chinese Taipei : US 600, Brazil : US 700, Canada : US 500, Hungary and Germany : US 200.**
