- Venue: Table Tennis Indoor Stadium, Chongchun Street, Pyongyang

3. Events

The following events will be played in the Tournament

- Men's team
- Women's team

4. Team composition

- Each participating team consists of 14 persons including 1 team leader, 1 official, 2 coaches and 10 players (5 male and 5 female).
- Hosting Association will enter 30 players (15 male and 15 female) in the tournament.

5. System of play

(1) Team events

There will be 2 stages for the team event

- 1st stage: the teams will be divided into 2 groups and will play round robin system.
- 2nd stage: based on the results of the 1st stage competitions, the teams will compete with the system as below;

Winner of group A vs. runner-up of group B,

Winner of group B vs. runner-up of group A

(The winners of these matches will compete for the 1st and 2nd place and the losers of these matches will compete for the 3rd and 4th place.)

3rd placed team of group A vs. 4th placed team of group B,

4th placed team of group A vs. 3rd placed team of group B

(The winners of these matches will compete for the 5th and 6th place and the losers of these matches will compete for the 7th and 8th place)

- Team events will be played as best of 5 games in all competitions

(2) Singles and Doubles events

- Singles events will be played on knockout system with best of 7 games.
- Doubles events will be played on knockout system with the best of 7 games.

6. Equipment

- Table: Butterfly (blue)
- Net: Butterfly (blue)
- Ball: Butterfly (white)

7. Awards

- The 1st placed team will be awarded the Tournament trophy and gold medal. 2nd and 3rd placed teams will be awarded silver and bronze medals respectively.
- The winners of the Singles and Doubles events will be awarded trophy and gold medals. The 2nd and 3rd placed players will be awarded silver and bronze medals respectively.
