#### 1.1 Boys

### 2. Playing System

#### 2.1 Cadet Boys' & Cadet Girls' Team Events

##### 2.1.1 Fixtures

Each fixture consists of five singles matches.  
The order of play is: A v X, B v Y, C v Z, A v Y, B v X.  
Each singles' match is best of five games.

##### 2.1.2 Stages

The competition is played in two stages.

##### 2.1.2.1 Stage 1

There are 2 groups with 4 teams in each group.  
All teams play each other.  
All five singles' matches must be played in the first stage.

##### 2.1.2.2 Stage 2

The teams finishing in first and second places in each group in Stage One progress to the semi-finals.

The teams finishing in third and fourth places in each group in Stage One compete for places 5-8.

In Stage Two a match finishes when one team has recorded three singles' wins

##### 2.1.3 Seeding

The continental teams who finished in the highest position at the 2006 World Cadet Challenge will be drawn into positions 1 in each group.  
The national association who received the ITTF Wild Card and the next highest ranked continental team at the 2006 World Cadet Challenge will be drawn into position 2 in each group.  
The next two highest ranked continental teams at the 2006 World Cadet Challenge will be drawn in position 3 in each group.  
The remaining continental team and the team representing the host association will be drawn into position 4 in each group.

##### 2.1.4 Restrictions

Teams from the same continent will be drawn into different groups.



## 2.2 Cadet Boys' & Cadet Girls' Singles

- 2.2.1 Stages                      The competition is played in two stages.
- 2.2.2.1 Stage 1                      Players will be drawn into 8 groups with 4 players in each group. All matches are best of five games.
- Players from the same team will be drawn into different groups and, if possible, players from the same continent will also be drawn into different groups.
- 2.2.2.2 Stage 2                      Players finishing in first and second places in each group in Stage One progress to play for Places 1-16.
- Winner of group A will go to position 1, winner of group B to position 16, winners of groups C & D will be drawn by lot to positions 8 & 9 and winners of groups E, F, G, & H by lot to positions 4, 5, 12 & 13. The winners and runners up will be drawn into opposite halves; after that criteria will be separation by teams (first) and if possible by continents (second).
- The Progressive Knock-Out system will be used to determine places 1-16
- Players finishing in third and fourth places in each group in Stage One progress to play for Places 17-32.
- The Progressive Knock-Out system will be used to determine places 17-32.
- All matches to determine the champion** will be best of seven games.
- All other matches** will be best of five games.
- 2.2.2 Seeding                      Seeding list will be provided by the ITTF Ranking Committee Chairman.

## 2.3 Cadet Boys' & Cadet Girls' Doubles

- 2.3.1 Playing System              The Progressive Knock-Out system will be used throughout.
- 2.3.2 Restrictions                      Pairs from the same team will be drawn in different halves and, if possible, pairs from the same continent will be drawn in different quarters.
- 2.3.3 Matches                          All matches will be best of 5 games.
- 2.3.4 Seeding                          Seeding list will be provided by the ITTF Ranking Committee Chairman.

## 3. Jury Meeting and Draw

- 3.1 Team Events' Draw              The Jury Meeting and Draw for the team events will be held on October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2007 at 15:30 h in the Meeting Room of the Good Hope Center.
- 3.2 Individual Events                      The Draw for the first stage of the singles' events will be held on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2007 at 18:00 h in the Meeting Room of the Good Hope Center.
- The Draw for the doubles' events will be held on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2007 at 18:30 in the Meeting Room of the Good Hope Center.



The Draw for the second stage of both the Boys' and Girls' Singles event will be held in the Meeting Room of the Good Hope Centre on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2007. The Girls' Singles Draw will start at 19.00 hours and the Boys' Singles Draw will follow at 19.15 hours.

## 4. Points System

### 4.1 Introduction

4.1.1 Standings Points are awarded in all cadet events to determine the final standings of each team at the conclusion of the competition.

### 4.2 Cadet Boys' & Cadet Girls' Team Events

4.2.1 Value Each win in an individual singles' match is worth one point.  
Example: a 3-2 result will earn three points for the winning team and 2 points for the losing team.

4.2.2 Bonus Points In addition, there are Bonus Points related to each team's final position.

4.2.3 Bonus Pts (Places) The Bonus Points are awarded for teams finishing in the following places follows:

1st: 18 pts	3rd: 10 pts	5th: 4 pts	7th: 2 pts
2nd: 14 pts	4th: 8 pts	6th: 3 pts	8th: 1 pt

### 4.3 Cadet Boys' & Cadet Girls' Singles

4.3.1 Stage One Each win in a singles match in Stage One is worth 2 points

4.3.2 Places 1-2 Each win in a singles match in Stage Two when competing for Places 1 & 2 is multiplied by 2.00

4.3.3 Places 3-6 Each win in a singles match in Stage Two when competing for places 3 to 6 is multiplied by 1.50

4.3.4 Places 7-10 Each win in a singles match in Stage Two when competing for places 7 to 10 is multiplied by 1.00

4.3.5 Places 11-14 Each win in a singles match in Stage Two when competing for places 11 to 14 is multiplied by 0.75

4.3.6 Places 15-18 Each win in a singles match in Stage Two when competing for places 15 to 18 is multiplied by 0.75

4.3.7 Places 19-26 Each win in a singles match in Stage Two when competing for places 19 to 26 is multiplied by 0.50

4.3.8 Places 27-32 Each win in a singles match in Stage Two when competing for places 27 to 32 is multiplied by 0.25

4.3.9 Bonus Points In addition, there are Bonus Points related to each player's final position



4.3.10 Bon. Pts. (System) The Bonus Points are awarded to players finishing in the following places follows:

- 4.4.3 Places 3-6 Each win in a doubles match when competing for places 3 to 8 is multiplied by 1.50
- 4.4.4 Places 9-10 Each win in a doubles match when competing for places 9 & 10 is multiplied by 1.00
- 4.4.5 Places 11-12 Each win in a doubles match when competing for places 11 & 12 is multiplied by 0.75
- 4.4.6 Places 13-14 Each win in a doubles match when competing for places 13 & 14 is multiplied by 0.50
- 4.4.7 Bonus Points In addition, there are Bonus Points related to each player's final position
