

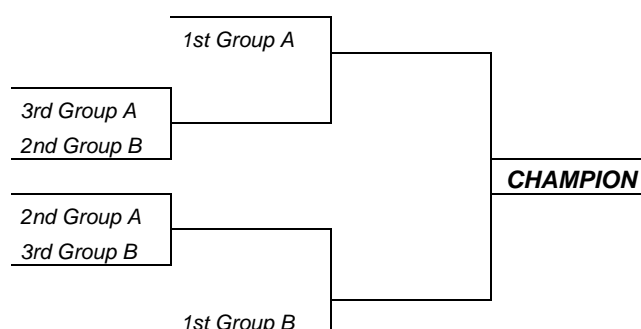
- 1.1 Boys Junior Boys' Singles
1.2 Girls Junior Girls' Singles

2. Playing System: Stage One

- 2.1 Groups 2 groups of 6 players (round robin system)
2.2 Matches All matches are best of 7 games
2.3 Draw The Draw is based on the ITTF World Junior Ranking 1st October **NOT** in the WJC Standings
Players from the same association will be drawn in different groups using the modified snake system
Two players will be drawn at a time relevant to their ITTF World Ranking, one player into Group A, one player into Group B

3. Playing System: Stage Two

- 3.1 Qualification Players finishing first, second and third in each group progress to play for positions 1 to 6
Players finishing fourth, fifth and sixth in each group progress to play for positions 7 to 12
3.2 System Stage Two is played on the Knock-Out system
3.3 Draw The Winner of Group A is drawn into Position No. 1; the Winner of Group B is drawn into Position No. 8. Both receive byes in the Round One.
3.4 Quarter-Finals Match A: The player finishing in 3rd place in Group A will play the player finishing in 2nd place in Group B
Match B: The player finishing in 2nd place in Group A will play the player finishing in 3rd place in Group B
3.5 Semi-Finals Match C: The Winner of Match A will play the Winner of Group A
Match D: The Winner of Match B will play the Winner of Group B
3.6 Final The Winner of Match C will play the Winner of Match D



3.7 Draw 2 The Fourth Placed Player in Group A is drawn into Position No. 1; the Fourth Placed Player in Group B is drawn into Position No. 8. Both receive byes in the Round One.

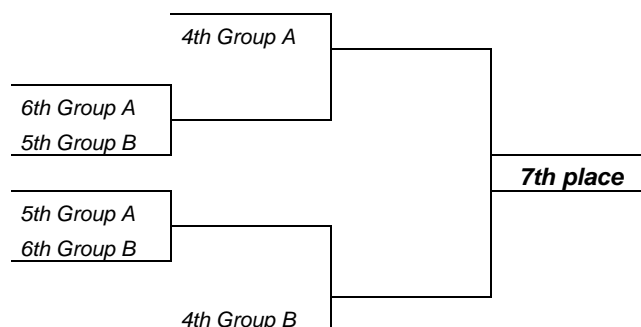
3.8 Places 7-12 Match E: The player finishing in 6th place in Group A will play the player finishing in 5th place in Group B

Match F: The player finishing in 5th place in Group A will play the player finishing in 6th place in Group B

3.9 Places 7-10 Match G: The Winner of Match E will play the Fourth Placed Player from Group A

Match H: The Winner of Match F will play the Fourth Placed Player from Group B

3.10 Places 7-8 The Winner of Match G will play the Winner of Match H for 7th and 8th Places
