

The World Table Tennis Championships 2009 in Yokohama

International Ticket Sales Regulations

Article 1: (Scope and Amendments Regarding This Agreement)

1. This Agreement applies to both the Organizing Committee and ticket applicants with regards to individual registrations and ticket applications for overseas ticket sales for this event as provided on the Internet (not including cellular phone access) by the Japan Organizing Committee (hereafter, "Organizing Committee") for the World Table Tennis Championships 2009.
2. Upon accessing the Web site to make a ticket application, the applicant assumes full responsibility and will act in accordance with this Agreement in good intention.

Article 2: (Application Rejection)

The Organizing Committee will refuse ticket applications when:

1. The applicant submits a false statement or does not submit all the necessary information.
2. The applicant acts in a way that inconveniences another applicant or third party, or the applicant acts in a way that is adverse to Organizing Committee sales.
3. The applicant does not carry out a prescribed procedure within the period specified by the Organizing Committee.
4. The applicant does not submit an application in the manner prescribed by the Organizing Committee.

Article 3: (Ticket Replacements, Amendments and Cooling-off Conditions)

Tickets for which payment has been finalized under consent from the applicant cannot be replaced, amended or canceled for any reason whatsoever. Furthermore, tickets are not subject to a cooling-off period.

Article 4: (Loss and Theft)

Tickets will not be reissued under any circumstances (including loss, theft and damage).

Article 5: (Refunds)

If the details of this event are altered or the event canceled altogether, applicants will be sent notification by the Organizing Committee. Applicants will be reimbursed unless the Organizing Committee deems otherwise. Furthermore, monies will be reimbursed during the period specified by the Organizing Committee, and at no other times shall reimbursements be made. Only the face value of tickets shall be reimbursed, and all additional fees (such as service charges or transportation, accommodation and correspondence fees) shall remain the responsibility of the applicant.

Article 6: (Application Restrictions)

Restrictions apply to applications with regard to the following: the number of matches, the number of tickets and payment methods.

Article 7: (Overseas Sales Period)

The application period extends from 10 February 2009 to 31 March 2009. All successful applicants will be notified of the results via e-mail.

Article 8: (Ticket Pricing)

The price for all tickets sold by the Organizing Committee will be specified in yen-denominations, regardless of whether the sale takes place within Japan or overseas.

Article 9: (Delivery & Receipt of Tickets)

1. Applicants are able to take receipt of tickets they have purchased from the Organizing Committee through the Overseas Sales Website at the first match attended following confirmation of your [Ticket Confirmation Slip]and[Passport].
2. Payment is in Japanese yen only. No credit card is accepted.

Article 10: (Prohibited Uses)

The sale of any tickets purchased from the Organizing Committee to a third party for the purpose of making a profit or providing a third party with such tickets for the purpose of re-sale is prohibited. The re-sale of tickets for an amount exceeding the face value of the ticket or an attempt to do the same is regulated by law in Japan. The re-sale of tickets at an auction, placing tickets on auction over the Internet or attempting to do the

same is also prohibited. In the event you are found to have committed any of the above, the Organizing Committee may, at its own discretion, void purchased tickets without refund and refuse entry into events. Applicants already having gained entry into an event may also be ordered to leave. The Organizing Committee shall not accept responsibility for tickets that have not been purchased directly from the Organizing Committee.

Article 11 (Miscellaneous)

In addition to the above listed conditions, applicants must also observe the laws and regulations of Japan and the laws and regulations set forth by local governing bodies.

Supplementary Clause: These regulations will take effect as of 10:00 am Japan Standard Time on 1 January 2009.
