Penalties for cancellation after the cancellation deadline will subject to penalties according to the <u>World Ranking Regulations 2019</u>.

- (Updated) Change of the composition of a team may be accepted if notified by a representative of the nominating Association to the Competition Manager, up to the time of **4 November 12:00 (local time)**; no further changes will be accepted after this deadline.
- **Default** Teams, which do not complete the first stage of the "round robin" group matches for whatever reason will be considered as "defaulted" and will not be eligible for any prize money.

Travel	All Teams should submit their arrival/departure details by <b>Sunday 20th October</b> , <b>2019</b> and send it to E-Mail address <u>international@jtta.or.jp</u> <b>and</b> <u>zena@ittf.com</u> as well. Those who submitted their details will be picked up at Haneda Airport / Narita Airport.

Room	<b>Deadline</b> for room cancellations is Sunday 27th October, 2019
Cancellation	If a player or accompanied person will cancel after that deadline the Association have to pay <b>US\$ (320)</b> cancellation fee per person (even two persons have shared a room, <b>2 x US\$320</b> fee has to be paid.
Miscellaneous	Doping controls shall be carried out in accordance with ITTF Anti Doping rules. Other relevant information such as travel, draw, press conference and practice time will be provided on the ITTF website in the section of "World Events" and "World Cups".
Important Information	Players must wear the official back numbers provided by the organizers/ITTF. They shall also have their names printed on the back of their shirts if possible. Players are not allowed to start the matches without the official numbers on the back of their shirts.
	Teams who finish among the top two (2) positions have an obligation to attend the prize ceremony in sports clothing (tracksuits) including sports shoes. Teams who will not fulfill this obligation will lose the prize money.
	All entered associations, pairs and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, Internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind.
	Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.
	By entering the event, all delegation members agree to abide by all ITTF rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee, including, but not limited by the ITTF's anti-doping rules (Chapter 5 of the 2019 ITTF Handbook)
	In the context of betting participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever, infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct, or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition, or any part thereof, in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF regulation 3.5.3.
	By entering the event, each association must ensure that all delegation members have medical, travel and other appropriate insurance.
