

2020 ITTF Para Polish Open Władysławowo, 20-22 February

The Polish Table Tennis Federation invites a total of 30 International Umpires to officiate at 2020 ITTF Para Polish Open. This tournament is staged in Władysławowo, from Thursday 20th February till Saturday 22nd February 2020.

Władysławowo is a town on the south coast of the Baltic Sea in pomeranian region in northern Poland. The tournament will take place at the Olympic Training Center, in a closed area.

It's an open invitation. Therefore not all nominations may be accepted. Furthermore, only nominations submitted by national associations or national URC will be considered.

Hospitality

Hospitality is offered from dinner on Wednesday 19th February till breakfast on Sunday 23rd February 2020. Each umpire will receive a daily allowance of 25 US\$ (22 EURO) per competition day, according to ITTF rules.

Transport

Transport will be provided from / to Lech Walesa International Airport in Gdansk and from / to Railway station in Gdynia. All invited umpires must organize their own transport to Władysławowo as well as travel and medical insurance.

Visa Application

Should a nominated umpire require a visa, kindly send scan of passport. A letter of invitation will be provided. Please note that all costs associated with the visa application are the responsibility of the applicant and the issuance of a visa is at the sole discretion of the relevant Consulate or Embassy.

Umpires' uniforms

Umpires must wear the International umpiring uniforms as described in the Handbook for Match Officials.

Deadline

The closing date for nominations is Monday 20th January 2020. The list of umpires accepted will be advised on Friday 21st January 2020.
