### 1. World Cadet Challenge

#### **1-World Cadet Challenge:**

□ For 2018-2019-2020: We agreed that the number of the participants will be reduced from 8 Teams to 6 Teams as follow :

Asia 1, Africa 1, Europe 1, Oceania 1, Panam 1, Host 1

- For Singles Events Main draw without playing Position 3 & 4, both Medallists,
- Team Event , The 4th Player of the Team could play if the result is 3-0 or 3-1,
- We need to have the agreement of North America & Latin America in order to have one Team Panam
- Hopes Team will not attend the WCC , will be more involved in Hopes Events and Camps
- Maintain the continental factor : Qualification Through the Continent
- Promote a deeper integration with Continental development through the new strategic investment agreement with the Continents
- Last WCC will be 2020 in Thailand

#### 1. World Cadet Challenge

## 2. World Junior Championships

- □ The ITTF World Junior Championships is need of constant support and backing as it is by no means safe to say that all the best juniors in the world will play in the World juniors each year.
- We will need to safeguard and promote World Junior Championships by thinking about ranking ,with the new 2018 ranking System we are afraid that our best junior players will not be interested to attend the WJTTC, therefore; this event needs to be considered in the General Ranking



### 3. World Junior Circuit

#### **World Junior Circuit:**

- Number of junior events/year: the commissioners think that the number of events should be reduced to increase the level of the events with a limit per continent.
- **Minimum participation for a WJC event:** Again the proposals have to come from the continents
- **Umpires per table for the WJC:** 1 per table for all group matches (individuals and teams).
- **Events evaluation:** Need to use an efficient Tournament Evaluation Report in order to have the real Evaluation.
- > ITTF to maintain quality control
- > It is my hope that the report itself reflects the real situation of our events
- **Bids:** All the bids received in the past are a simple application form, at the end all bids are accepted which is not normal

## 4. World Junior Circuit Final

WJCF Luxembourg will be the last edition (No big interest having the event played at the beginning of the new Season and the top players did not attend many editions ,Having (WCC,WJTTC,WJCF) in a row is not good for our Juniors event , should give top priority to our main Junior Competition the WJTTC
