

# 2020 ITTF Challenge Polish Open Gliwice, 11-15 March

The Polish Table Tennis Federation invites a total of 30 International Umpires to officiate at 2020 ITTF Challenge Polish Open. This tournament is staged in Gliwice, from Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March till Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

Gliwice is a city in the south part of Poland in Silesian region. The tournament will take place at the Gliwice Arena, 50 Akademicka street, Gliwice 44-100.

It's an open invitation. Therefore not all nominations may be accepted. Furthermore, only nominations submitted by national associations or national URC will be considered.

## **Hospitality**

Hospitality is offered from dinner on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March till breakfast on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2020. Each umpire will receive a daily allowance of 30 US\$ or equivalent currency in euro per competition day, according to ITTF rules.

### **Transport**

Transport will be provided from / to Katowice International Airport in Katowice and from / to Railway station in Katowice and Gliwice. All invited umpires must organize their own transport to Gliwice as well as travel and medical insurance.

#### **Visa Application**

Should a nominated umpire require a visa, kindly send scan of passport. A letter of invitation will be provided. Please note that all costs associated with the visa application are the responsibility of the applicant and the issuance of a visa is at the sole discretion of the relevant Consulate or Embassy.

#### **Umpires' uniforms**

Umpires must wear the International umpiring uniforms as described in the Handbook for Match Officials.

## **Deadline**

The closing date for nominations is Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2020. The list of umpires accepted will be advised on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2020.
