2020 ITTF Challenge Polish Open Gliwice, 11-15 March

The Polish Table Tennis Federation invites a total of 30 International Umpires to officiate at 2020 ITTF Challenge Polish Open. This tournament is staged in Gliwice, from Wednesday 11th March till Sunday 15th March 2020.

Gliwice is a city in the south part of Poland in Silesian region. The tournament will take place at the Gliwice Arena, 50 Akademicka street, Gliwice 44-100.

It's an open invitation. Therefore not all nominations may be accepted. Furthermore, only nominations submitted by national associations or national URC will be considered.

Hospitality

Hospitality is offered from dinner on Tuesday 10th March till breakfast on Monday 16th March 2020. Each umpire will receive a daily allowance of 30 US\$ or equivalent currency in euro per competition day, according to ITTF rules.

Transport

Transport will be provided from / to Katowice International Airport in Katowice and from / to Railway station in Katowice and Gliwice. All invited umpires must organize their own transport to Gliwice as well as travel and medical insurance.

Visa Application

Should a nominated umpire require a visa, kindly send scan of passport. A letter of invitation will be provided. Please note that all costs associated with the visa application are the responsibility of the applicant and the issuance of a visa is at the sole discretion of the relevant Consulate or Embassy.

Umpires' uniforms

Umpires must wear the International umpiring uniforms as described in the Handbook for Match Officials.

Deadline

The closing date for nominations is Monday **20th January 2020**. The list of umpires accepted will be advised on Wednesday **22nd January 2020**.
