

# In-Competition testing Local Organising Committee (LOC) checklist

# **DOPING CONTROL STATION (DCS)**

The DCS should be located as close as possible to the field of play, solely used for anti-doping purposes, lockable and accessible only to authorised personnel.

DCS must be clean and equipped with running water and electricity.


DCS location must be signposted.

DCS must be separated in three different areas as follows:

WAITING ROOM		ARRANGED
1	Ventilation and/or opened windows, and heated.	
2	Comfortable seats	
3	Secure access / not accessible to members of the public	
4	Located close to the processing room	
5	Garbage bin (optional)	
6	Sealed bottles of mineral water	
7	Table at the entrance to record the flow of athlete/staff entering (optional)	
8	TV screen to monitor the ongoing competition (optional)	
PROCESSING ROOM (per processing area)		
1	One desk with at least two chairs	
2	Cabinet to store the anti-doping material such as sample collection kits	
3	Power & internet Access	
4	Garbage bin	
5	Ventilation and/or opened windows, and heated.	
LAVATORIES (per processing area)		
1	Directly accessible from the processing room	
2	Large enough to allow the DCO witnessing the passing of the sample	
3	Paper towels and toilet paper in sufficient quantity	
4	Lockable door	
5	Mirror on the wall behind the toilet to facilitate the witnessing of sample provision (optional)
