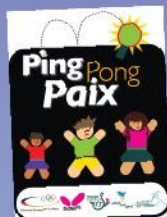

Board of Trustees

Controlling body.
Composed of **(proposal)**: ITTF Vice President in charge of finances, ITTF Ethics Commission Representative, Others (and n°) to be defined



Governing Board

Supreme and legally responsible body, oversees the activities of the foundation, sets out the overall strategic direction, sets out strategic objectives, approves annual budget, etc.
Composed of **(proposal)**: ITTF President and/or ITTF Executive Committee Representative, influential Philanthropists of the Table Tennis or Sport Community, FIT Representative "Ex Officio", Management Team Representative (n° to be defined)



Management Team

Executes the decisions from the Governing Board and submits proposals to the Governing Board.



(in second stage): Active and passive members + volunteers

Potential Legally Registered Office

Switzerland vs. Germany

Similar laws about the establishment, controlling and managing of a non-profit foundation.
Both are regulated and controlled through a Foundation's Oversight Committee and the local revenue.

Administration and costs are higher in Switzerland (both for the establishment and the regular administration as:

- **audit has to be made by independent auditors**
- **oversight committee charges for each activity 100 – 3,000 CHF (while this is free in Germany)**
